This is to certify that I did on the 14th day of March 1833 solemnize the rites of Matrimony between John Washburn and Sarah Davis according to law, the first having produced to me a license from the Clerk of the Switzerland Circuit Court. Given under my hand and seal this 14<sup>th</sup> day of March 1833.
