## *Descendants of Conrad Burns*

**1. Conrad<sup>1</sup> Burns** was born Abt. 1735 in Scotland, and died 1784 in Anson Co., NC. He married **Hannah Frey/Fry**.

Notes for Conrad Burns:

Conrad arrived on the ship "Halifax" which sailed from Rotterdam under Captain Thomas Coatman. His name appears as Conrad Bornn on the passenger list. It may have actually have been Börn or Börner. Death(5,6,7): "[... ] In 1784 he decided to leave his adulterous wife and move out west. He sold most of his personal property at that time. Records indicate that on the first night out (about 25 miles from home) the team of horses broke loose from his wagon. Conrad may have been thinking that the horses would return home and he decided to search for them. He became lost and died of a heart attack...." [Note by Michael Motes] His son, Phillip Burns, Jr., served a 3-month draft enlistment for him while he was serving another drafted term to fight the Cherokees. the name of family was spelled "Buen" in Germany per Anne W. McAllister. He owned land in Lincoln Co. NC (now apparently Catawba Co. NC near Hickory), inherited by his son, Phillip Burns, Sr. [Taken from Rootsweb World Connect site, Noel Family Tree from 1530 France to Mercer Co., Kentucky, Jim Gayheart]

Philip Burns

January 15, 1846

February 19, 1849

Being old and in a decline of life, etc. Should my wife Catherine Burns out live me I give to her one negro boy named Major and one negro girl named Priscilla and one bed and all it's fixtures and one cow and calf during her natural life. And at her death all to be returned to my executor and disposed of as herein directed.

I wish my executor to alot to my wife Catherine one year's provision. I wish farther that my executor give my wife Catherine \$50.00 a year. However, if she should find her keep to cost more then that he shall give more. I wish after my death my black woman Abbie to be set free, etc.

I give Abby a cow and wheel as soon as can be after my death. My executor will sell all of residue of my estate to the highest bidder. All my negroes on a credit of twelve months and my land on a credit of two years, etc.

I desire that my executor divide the money from the sale among my children share and share alike. With the understanding that all the notes, accounts and etc that I have against any one of them shall be counted as that much money received by them. And as Jacob Ruby the husband of my daughter Kate has received \$200.00 and as I have no receipt from him he is hereby charged with that amount. And furthermore Susan, Phillip, Jacob and Nicholas have each received a negro from me. They will each show the bill of sale I gave them to my executor, etc.

And again my executor is directed to take the share that is coming to my daughter Elizabeth Lewis now in Illinois

and lay it out for land and have the deed made out to her and her children, etc.

And I wish my executor to be paid for all the time and trouble his expenses as the percentage I allowed for collecting and distributing and lastly I do appoint my friend Montford Peter my executor of this my last will, etc.

Phillip was a private in the military, being drafted in North Carolina for three months to guard prisoners and help build a stockade. In 1781, he substituted for his uncle, John George Fry, for another 3 months in South Carolina. He marched to the Catawba Frontier as a substitute for his father who had been drafted to fight the Cherokees. He was serving in the North Carolina Continental Line when the War ended. Pension #S30909. He is listed in Anderson Chenault Quisenberry's compilation (additions by Collins) as 84-year old pensioner living in Washington Co. KY, 1840. In 1784 he inherited his father's land in Lincoln Co. NC. In 1797 he was on the Garrard Co. KY tax list and owned 150 acres on Glens Creek in Washington Co. KY. In 1802 he owned land in Clark Co. KY. In 1805 he was first listed on the Washington Co. KY tax lists.(Compiled by Rebecca Conover, Harrodsburg KY, July 1979.)

Dr. William J. Springfield, Vanover Precinct, was born in Webster (then Hopkins) County, Jan. 22, 1843, and is a son of John Springfield, a native of Virginia, who came to Kentucky in 1839. The Doctor was brought up on a farm, and educated in the common schools. He graduated from Cincinnati Medical College in June, 1874, and located for the practice of medicine in West Louisville, the same year. In 1875 he removed to his farm in this precinct, where he still lives, and has built up a large practice. He also carries on farming and stock-raising. He married in 1875, to Mrs. Rafferty, daughter of the late Lewis I. Burns, of this county. They had two children, one living - Aurelia. Mrs. Springfield died June 20, 1880, and March 10, 1881, the Doctor married Miss Belle Aull, daughter of Robert P. Aull, deceased. They had one child - Ansel. The Doctor owns 106-1/2 acres in his farm, and an undivided one third of seventy-two acres in another tract.

Bethel an equal part with the rest of my children after he has paid the estate the sum of \$200 which I have already given to him. I give to Samuel T. Bethel the sum of one dollar. I give to Leona, Henry H. Benjamin F., Florence A., Joseph M., and equal share after the youngest child is 21 years of age. My daughter Leona is to have the care of and the raising of the children until the youngest child is 21 and for the same is to have the use of the entire estate after the payment of all just and honest debts. I sign this my last will and testament this the 25th day of December 1901.
