MOSES STREET JONES

The name Jones is of Welsh origin. Research-ers found that it was first spelled Johnys, then Johnes and later Jones. My great grandfather Moses Jones was born May 27, 1797 in Mecklenburg County, Virginia. He was the son of Richard and Jane Comer Jones. It has been said that his parents were accident victims which left their son an orphan at an early age. A maternal family friend named Thomas Street of Person Coun-ty, N.C. took the lad and raised him.

Appreciation of the kindness of the man who befriended him caused Moses Jones to name one of his sons Moses Street Jones. My grandfather Moses Street Jones was born March 2, 1834 in Person County. He was seventh of ten children of Moses and Joanna Boltin Springfield Jones who were married November 11, 1819.

Other children are: Richard, born 9-15--1820, married Martha Ann Gentry 1-10-1839, death date unknown; William, born 9-6-1822, married Jane Brooks 12-15-1842, died 2-29--1896, buried beside his wife in Shiloh Church Cemetery; Elizabeth Comer Jones, born 9-26-1824, married William Walker 11-25-1840, died 6-1-1851; James Wesley, born 11-5--1826, married Mahaly S. Burton 4-20-1848, death date unknown; John Richmond born 6-20-1829, died 2-26-1897 (Tombstone has birthdate 8-1-1829); Gabriel Yancey born 2--17-1832 died 4-26-1862, buried in Jones Family Cemetery; Calvin born 8-11-1836, married Patty Morton, buried at Milton; Jane Jones born 9-6-1839, married John B. Day 11-28-1860; Threeza Loyd born 10-5-1842, married a Southerland and moved to Missouri.

Moses S. Jones was a slim man of medium height with blue grey eyes and reddish hair. He wore a beard most of his adult life. He loved to work and worked long hours on the farm. He was known to complain that he was never able to lift a "2 bushel sack of shelled corn." During his life time Moses S. Jones was astute in buying and selling land. At one time he owned several thousand acres of land in the Bethel Hill, Woodsdale areas and in Virginia along the border plus property in the town of Roxboro. He established a home in Woods-dale township about five miles from the Vir-ginia line. Tenant families worked the land either for half or fourth share of their profit depending on whether they owned their team (mules). In 1909 Mr. Jones built a brick vaneer hotel in Roxboro on the site of the frame Dowdy Hotel (site of present P.H. Rose Store). It was known as the Jones Hotel until it was renamed Hotel Roxboro. It was abolished in 1961.

Moses S. Jones was one of the 12 men granted certificate of incorporation for the Peoples Bank (now First Union) chartered dur-ing the 1891 session of the N.C. legislature.

During the Civil War, Moses S. Jones was a soldier in Company K of the 12th N.C. Reg-iment, under General Early. While in service he had measles and stayed in a feed barn until he was able to return to duty.

Moses S. Jones was past forty years old when in 1880 he married the first time. His wife was Bettie King Rogers, a widow eight years his junior, with one son Zeb Rogers. She died a few years later and was buried in the Rogers cemetery at Woodsdale. Mr. Jones provided for his step-son to attend A & E College (N.C. State) to study Architectural En-gineering. According to my mother, Zeb Rog-ers designed Pennsylvania Railroad Station in Washington, D.C.

On March 1, 1894 Moses S. Jones married a seconfime, Addie F. Jones of Brunswick County, Virginia. Unfortunately, she died October 22, 1895, one day after giving birth to a daughter. The infant was named Addie Gar-nett. Two years later Mr. Jones married Ida Jones, his second wife's sister. Ten years later in 1907 Moses Jones was a widower for the third time.

Grandfather's mother Joanna lived with him for many years after her husband's death in August 1854. She was 98 years, 2 months of age when she died in 1897. Both Moses and his wife Joanna are buried in the Jones Family Cemetery. Also, Joanna's parents Moses and Betsy Springfield are buried in the Jones Fami-ly Cemetery. This cemetery is located near the Moses Jones' family home which now stands empty and in bad repair. The home site is located about one mile bff State Road 1322 approximately three forth

mile East of Woods-dale.

Though he had little formal education, M.S. Jones was an advocate of education. Besides providing for his step son's education, he gave financial assistance to ministerial students who attended Bethel Hill Institute, the boarding school founded by the Rev. J.A. Beam. Later, when the need arose for a more centrally located school in the community, Mr. Jones was serving on the local school board. He gave land and the rough timber for a new elementary school at the site of the present Bethel Hill school. Date of deed is September 1919. Anticipating that he would have grand-children to be educated (I was the only one in 1919) grandfather set up a scholarship fund at Meredith and Wake Forest Colleges. Four grandchildren benefitted from these scholarships.

Moses S. Jones was 86 when he died May 19, 1920. He is buried beside his second wife Addie at Bethel Hill Church where he had been a faithful and contributing member.

Dr. William J. Springfield, Vanover Precinct, was born in Webster (then Hopkins) County, Jan. 22, 1843, and is a son of John Springfield, a native of Virginia, who came to Kentucky in 1839. The Doctor was brought up on a farm, and educated in the common schools. He graduated from Cincinnati Medical College in June, 1874, and located for the practice of medicine in West Louisville, the same year. In 1875 he removed to his farm in this precinct, where he still lives, and has built up a large practice. He also carries on farming and stock-raising. He married in 1875, to Mrs. Rafferty, daughter of the late Lewis I. Burns, of this county. They had two children, on living - Aurelia. Mrs. Springfield died June 20, 1880, and March 10, 1881, the Doctor married Miss Belle Aull, daughter of Robert P. Aull, deceased. They had one child - Ansel. The Doctor owns 106-1/2 acres in his farm, and an undivided one third of seventy-two acres in another tract.

The Ida Miller who is buried there has the following information on the tombstone: Born: April 15, 1878; Died August 25, 1907.

The birth date fits in the time frame with our Ida, but more research needs to be done to know for sure. The information for the little girl as Ida's daughter is Opal Miller, born October 14, 1901 and Died on October 27, 1907.
