5. **Sarah Ann² Davis** (Samuel¹) was born Abt. 1812 in Indiana. She married (1) **John Washburn** March 14, 1833 in Switzerland Co., IN. He was born in Kentucky, and died Abt. 1839. She married (2) **James Moore** October 17, 1842 in Switzerland Co., IN. He was born Abt. 1790 in Pennsylvania, and died Bef. 1860.

Notes for John Washburn:

Not much is known about the Washburn family other than Samuel and his descendants. Various branches of the family have stories with common threads. John died at an early age, probably between 1939 and 1942. They apparently had only two children: Samuel and John.

Samuel's death certificate lists his mother as Susanna Davis. However, this is incorrect. Her first name was Sarah. This is supported by several census records and the record of her second marriage. A year or so after John's death Sarah remarried a James Moore in Switzerland Co., Indiana.

It is known from living family members that there was at least one daughter by this marriage, Mollie (real name was Amanda), who married a William Herman who later became fire department captain for Jefferson Co., Kentucky.

The 1850 census records for Switzerland Co., Indiana shows a James Moore, age 60; with Sally, age 38; Samuel (listed without any indication of a Washburn surname), age 15; John, age 12 ; Permelia and Louisa, age 5; a daughter listed only as M., age 3; and an unnamed daughter age 1. The 1860 Carroll Co., Kentucky census shows Sarah A. Moore, age 42; Amanda Moore, age 17; Mary Moore, age 9; and Samuel Washburn, 25.

According to the 1920 census record for John's son, Samuel, both John and Sarah were born in Virginia, while

Samuel was born in Kentucky. The 1900 and 1910 census record for John's son, Samuel, indicates that Samuel, John and Sarah were all born in Indiana.

John was alive in May 1839 because he was mentioned in the settlement of his father-in-laws estate. Sarah is listed without a husband in the 1840 census. Presumably John died sometime between May 1839 and mid-1840 when the census was taken.

Be it remembered that on the 12th day of March A.D. 1833, I Edward Patton, Clerk of the Circuit Court for the county aforesaid, granted John Washburn and Sarah Davis marriage licences and afterwards to wit on the 18th day of March A.D. 1833, Amos A. Brown filed for ____ certificate in the words and figures following to wit . . . State of Indiana Switzerland County

This is to certify that I did on the 14th day of March 1833 solemnize the rites of Matrimony between John Washburn and Sarah Davis according to the laws the first having produced to me a license from the Clerk of Switzerland Circuit Court.

Given under my hand and seal this 14th day of March 1833
