The story of the struggle of the Von Sitier Heirg.
The Von Sitier heirs of this country and $\$ 350,000,000$ now in the hands of the German Government and said to be due them as hejrs of Baron Matthias Von Sitler, who diad in 1775 ( 1745 ) is ona of much interest. An effort was first made to aquire the fabulous sum In 1885 and has continued almost unceasingly until the present time when heirs say their prospects of becoming wealthyaane brighter now
thai ever.

Now that the struggle is believed to be drawing to a closs the members of the Matthias Sytsior Society roconcly requastod a Mro $W m$ 。 J. Siter of Robinson, Illinois, a great, great grandson of Matthias Sitlar who has been most untiring in his efforts to get tha millions for the rightful heirs, to write the story of how and why the treasures have never fallon to the heirs, and also to write an a ccount of what has been done aince 1885 to secure the money.

The skotch was read last night at a mesting of the Sociaty at the home of Mrs George Hoffrmen, 1100 North Strifcker Straet. Mr. Wmo Sitler also stated in his lettor that he would soon go to Germany to complete the investigation. The story as told by Ms. Wmo Sitl.ar is as follows.

Baron Von Sitler was the ownar of a large Baronial sstate In Bavaria, Germany, And was engaged also in the manufacturing of solks. With his already inhanited woalth and that made from his manufacturing it was estimated that his fortine emounted to at least $\$ 50,000,000$ ( fifty million dollars ) for he was counted to bo an extremely wealth man.

The old Baron was a staunch Catholic, but his two sons (Herman and Districh ) and one daughter (Elizaboth) Sjtlor bow came Pollowors of the great Martin Luther and ontered the folds of Protestantism. When the rumors of this cams to the Von Sitlar Castia and family and it poachod the ears of the testy did Lovedg he inmediataly called his children to him and scoseld them roughly and disowned them. The thres then decided to $28 a$ va the old country and to try their fortune in a now world. The father furnished a substantial sum and told them to meks the bast uss posaible of it as it would be ths last they would recelve from hims and they sat sall on Soptambor the 2 na, 1736 for America. After they loft the father dictated a most un-usual. will, investing his weaith in German Govermment Bonds and 99 year Bonds, when when realized the money was to be turned over to his children's children.

The voyage was estedious as all ocesn voyages in that dafo and the only incident which is of interest was tha robbary of part of the money was Dietrich carrisd. The little party landed in Philadelphia with Diotrich locating in Berics County, Penaa. and Matthias in York, Pann。Matthias puschased 250 acres of land in the vicinity of Yoric and thom building a houso and barns began his iffe in this country as a farmer.

The Lutheran Churech in York having a poos comgregastion as to funds, he built a church and conated it to its mamberso Ho and in 1740 ( ) moved to the fown of Baltumora, whiskat that a
and soon transfersed it into a beautiful Dutch Garden. This was the pride of his life. And he never expected to sell its but am English Admirer of the Garden, howewn dought ree peatodly 50 bret ${ }^{T} y$ and Matthias put what he thought was a prohibitive price on it, the figure being $\$ 60,000$ cash in English Gold. And it was paid without question as the records of the Court House show under the date of July 29, 1779"

Matthias then wrote his son Benjamin Sitler who was a Chief Commisary Officer to General George Washington, of the sale of the Garden and he stated that he was ready and willing to assist the cause of Liberty. This the son divuiged to General Washington, who immediately came to Baltimores under heavy escort. He dined with the wealthy German and left the same niEht with nintty-thousand dollass ( $\$ 90,000$ ) loaned him by Matthias Simler.

Kater when Prosident, Mr. Weshington repaid the note in full piving Matthias 60,000 acres of land located in the Shenandoah Vailay. Virginia, and the German al.so investod a ia rge amount ox money which he put out in 99 year loa ses. These las ses by Court records it is claimed having now oxpired. This proparty is located on Howard, Lerington, Fayet;ise and Lombard Stroets. Mr. Wm. Sitler says that he has made several visits to the city of Baltimors in an offort to straighten out this tangle。

Records of the family wers handed down from generation to generation until finally they odme into the hands of a Mrese Mary S. Sitler who resided in Baltimore. She disd in trus year of 8884 at the age of 85 years, Pricr to har death nowe ever Mrs A. H. Lyeth, her neice took the papers which were then stored in a barrell and burned the entire contentis. Mrs Sitier, objected tearfully, but Mrs Lygeth thought it was only a whim of hers kesping the cumbersome boxes of cild papers in the barrell and to get rid of them she burned the valuable records. $H_{a}$ d these papers been retained, it would hars been a very eass matter it is claimed, for the heirs to have establishsd their claims with the German Government; and to prove in 2885 they were to be the rightiul hoirs to the millions held by the Germans.

Tiring of the efforts of the others, Mrs Meary Sositior in 1884. this being just one year before she died, saic. that she would do what the male helrs had always feared to cio, and go to Germany herself. And she made preparation to visf.t Germany to astablish the elaim for the heirs. Mrs Sitlar was comfortably fixed with this worlds goods and mado aver'y proparation for the trip oven to packing her trunks and purchasing her tickets, when on the night before that she was plannlng for her departure. she was taken 111 and died several weeks later.

Then the following summer of 1885 the Garman Government sent an agent to this country to locate the heirs. He ea me to this country and statad that the 99 yoas swade were due in the German Government, who was raady to pay the money amounting to the sum of $\$ 350.000,000$ to the proper persons and happy to do it to clear their records.

The agent romadned in Baltimore Town for five months, His attarapts to get the Sitlar hairs to agres to a proper division ware fruitleas, The rich it ssemed wished to lessen the portions of the poorer heirs, but to this settlement the agent would not agpes, stating that the division would be made according to geneelogy ow it would not be made. at all. The authorized agent on his search for records proving the heirs, found in the old Eraveyard at Paca and Lombard streats the grave of ons Matthias Sitler and his wife。 "This is the man Iam aftar ${ }^{n}$ ho said. "Allow me to take these stones to Garmany and the authenticity of your claims will bo establishad. But factors having a rison betwaen the heirg the suggestion was rafused. And the agent roturned to his Emperor.

In 2880 ( date doesn't agres ) when the old Dunkard Graveyerd was sold and the tombstones wers removed, the tombstones wore placed in coffins, which was buriod in Gresmount Cometery. The stones were orizy inches below the surfacs of the ground in lot "Ensor's plot. This information Mr. Wme Sitior, Robinsong Il.inois, claims was gotton from the kesper of the cemotery in 1899, Rumor has it that since that time, ons stones has been stolen.

A second agent from Germany later hastatedthis country and called upon the Secretary of the Stats, but was told to have Thaddeus Stephons, who was Congressman from that part of Penn. near York to investigate the merits of the claim. Stephens made an investigation and offered to secure the monay for $\$ 2500$ in cash and $15 \%$ of the gmount sgcured as a lage. fes. This proposition the Pennsylvania heirs tierbut those of old Baltimore failed to raise thoir part of the mbney for the cash in advance. So this plan also iailod. About this time soveral Societiss were formod for bringing the heirs together and winning the German Gold. $\mathrm{Mr}_{2}$ 。Wmositler, who has worked hardar than any one of the others of the helres for success has traveled all over the country writing down cinims and making svary offort to bring the haiss together.

In 1903 The Society made more dstermined efforts in the ratter of subseribed funds to send an agant from this countyy to carry on an imvestrgation in that country. And for this tasky the Reverend $J_{0} V$ George of Ponna. was selected and deppartod June 24. 1903. He landod in Beriin, Garmany, safelyo But was almost immediately takan 111 and spent some time in a hospital there. Howover, $\mathrm{Mr}^{2}$. Wm. Sitlar in his story, says that after Mr. George recovered he made a trip to Southern Germany and visitod members of the Sitler family at that place. He than called on the Consul and beturned to the U.S.A.

Tha heirs claimed that his effort madi in the later part of the yoar was unesatisfactory. Since that time the didferent Socistios have attained attoxnoys both in Gormany and in this Country as well, who give legal advise and claim that according to the reports from Germany and this country, overything points to a spaody recovery of the $\$ 350,000,000$ due tham from the Gemman Govermment, if only the heirs could agreo. It is said there are about 250 heirs in this country among whom the milifons must be devided. Of thesa thers ars about fifteon in this cityo

I received the following date from Mre Raymond Wessendorfs Spese, Indiana in November, 1957 She has the original penciled copy writton in 1905. It belonged to her grandfather, J8hn $\AA_{0}$ LeMastor, who was a decendent of Matthias Sitler, through Catherine Sitler, who married Jesse LaMaster. Mrs Wossendorf wrote me quotes "Now it was in 1905, late in the Pall of the yoar that my Mother and my grandfather both told ree many timos, that a Benjamin Sitler from Baltimore, Maryland came to Speed, Indiana looking for hoirs to the Sitier fortune. Now this fortuns was strictiy "Baltimore "Bocause a Matthias Sitler had disd in Baltimore and his estate was never settled. Much the sa me as the old German fartune in Bavaria, Germany. It too never reached it's rightful heirs. That was loit by the old Baron Matthias Von Sitler or Matthias, Sro My Grandfatiser always said that the Boltimore Matthias was the son of Herman who settled in York, $\mathrm{Pe} /$ then in Beltimore. Because the story of the struggle if you notice never does even mention Hermans name after they landed ( it says Districh in Berks County, Pennsylvania) (Matthias in in Yoxis. Pennsylvania. Question arises who बix this Baltimore Matthies then helong too.? It is said that onlytwo sons and one daughter left the old country ( Elizabeth) my Grandfather always said thet Catherine and Elizabeth that marrisd LaMasters were of a Hortesm generation. This could be, they could have been nemed for theico German kinfolk. But this Baltinore Matthias was wealthy in his own rights, not ever heving got the German Bonds or gold end quote。

The story of the struggle of the Von Sitier Heirg.
The Von Sitier heirs of this country and $\$ 350,000,000$ now in the hands of the German Government and said to be due them as hejrs of Baron Matthias Von Sitler, who diad in 1775 ( 1745 ) is ona of much interest. An effort was first made to aquire the fabulous sum In 1885 and has continued almost unceasingly until the present time when heirs say their prospects of becoming wealthyaane brighter now
thai ever.

Now that the struggle is believed to be drawing to a closs the members of the Matthias Sytsior Society roconcly requastod a Mro $W m$ 。 J. Siter of Robinson, Illinois, a great, great grandson of Matthias Sitlar who has been most untiring in his efforts to get tha millions for the rightful heirs, to write the story of how and why the treasures have never fallon to the heirs, and also to write an a ccount of what has been done aince 1885 to secure the money.

The skotch was read last night at a mesting of the Sociaty at the home of Mrs George Hoffrmen, 1100 North Strifcker Straet. Mr. Wmo Sitler also stated in his lettor that he would soon go to Germany to complete the investigation. The story as told by Ms. Wmo Sitl.ar is as follows.

Baron Von Sitler was the ownar of a large Baronial sstate In Bavaria, Germany, And was engaged also in the manufacturing of solks. With his already inhanited woalth and that made from his manufacturing it was estimated that his fortine emounted to at least $\$ 50,000,000$ ( fifty million dollars ) for he was counted to bo an extremely wealth man.

The old Baron was a staunch Catholic, but his two sons (Herman and Districh ) and one daughter (Elizaboth) Sjtlor bow came Pollowors of the great Martin Luther and ontered the folds of Protestantism. When the rumors of this cams to the Von Sitlar Castia and family and it poachod the ears of the testy did Lovedg he inmediataly called his children to him and scoseld them roughly and disowned them. The thres then decided to $28 a$ va the old country and to try their fortune in a now world. The father furnished a substantial sum and told them to meks the bast uss posaible of it as it would be ths last they would recelve from hims and they sat sall on Soptambor the 2 na, 1736 for America. After they loft the father dictated a most un-usual. will, investing his weaith in German Govermment Bonds and 99 year Bonds, when when realized the money was to be turned over to his children's children.

The voyage was estedious as all ocesn voyages in that dafo and the only incident which is of interest was tha robbary of part of the money was Dietrich carrisd. The little party landed in Philadelphia with Diotrich locating in Berics County, Penaa. and Matthias in York, Pann。Matthias puschased 250 acres of land in the vicinity of Yoric and thom building a houso and barns began his iffe in this country as a farmer.

The Lutheran Churech in York having a poos comgregastion as to funds, he built a church and conated it to its mamberso Ho and in 1740 ( ) moved to the fown of Baltumora, whiskat that a
and soon transfersed it into a beautiful Dutch Garden. This was the pride of his life. And he never expected to sell its but am English Admirer of the Garden, howewn dought ree peatodly 50 bret ${ }^{T} y$ and Matthias put what he thought was a prohibitive price on it, the figure being $\$ 60,000$ cash in English Gold. And it was paid without question as the records of the Court House show under the date of July 29, 1779"

Matthias then wrote his son Benjamin Sitler who was a Chief Commisary Officer to General George Washington, of the sale of the Garden and he stated that he was ready and willing to assist the cause of Liberty. This the son divuiged to General Washington, who immediately came to Baltimores under heavy escort. He dined with the wealthy German and left the same niEht with nintty-thousand dollass ( $\$ 90,000$ ) loaned him by Matthias Simler.

Kater when Prosident, Mr. Weshington repaid the note in full piving Matthias 60,000 acres of land located in the Shenandoah Vailay. Virginia, and the German al.so investod a ia rge amount ox money which he put out in 99 year loa ses. These las ses by Court records it is claimed having now oxpired. This proparty is located on Howard, Lerington, Fayet;ise and Lombard Stroets. Mr. Wm. Sitler says that he has made several visits to the city of Baltimors in an offort to straighten out this tangle。

Records of the family wers handed down from generation to generation until finally they odme into the hands of a Mrese Mary S. Sitler who resided in Baltimore. She disd in trus year of 8884 at the age of 85 years, Pricr to har death nowe ever Mrs A. H. Lyeth, her neice took the papers which were then stored in a barrell and burned the entire contentis. Mrs Sitier, objected tearfully, but Mrs Lygeth thought it was only a whim of hers kesping the cumbersome boxes of cild papers in the barrell and to get rid of them she burned the valuable records. $H_{a}$ d these papers been retained, it would hars been a very eass matter it is claimed, for the heirs to have establishsd their claims with the German Government; and to prove in 2885 they were to be the rightiul hoirs to the millions held by the Germans.

Tiring of the efforts of the others, Mrs Meary Sositior in 1884. this being just one year before she died, saic. that she would do what the male helrs had always feared to cio, and go to Germany herself. And she made preparation to visf.t Germany to astablish the elaim for the heirs. Mrs Sitlar was comfortably fixed with this worlds goods and mado aver'y proparation for the trip oven to packing her trunks and purchasing her tickets, when on the night before that she was plannlng for her departure. she was taken 111 and died several weeks later.

Then the following summer of 1885 the Garman Government sent an agent to this country to locate the heirs. He ea me to this country and statad that the 99 yoas swade were due in the German Government, who was raady to pay the money amounting to the sum of $\$ 350.000,000$ to the proper persons and happy to do it to clear their records.

The agent romadned in Baltimore Town for five months, His attarapts to get the Sitlar hairs to agres to a proper division ware fruitleas, The rich it ssemed wished to lessen the portions of the poorer heirs, but to this settlement the agent would not agpes, stating that the division would be made according to geneelogy ow it would not be made. at all. The authorized agent on his search for records proving the heirs, found in the old Eraveyard at Paca and Lombard streats the grave of ons Matthias Sitler and his wife。 "This is the man Iam aftar ${ }^{n}$ ho said. "Allow me to take these stones to Garmany and the authenticity of your claims will bo establishad. But factors having a rison betwaen the heirg the suggestion was rafused. And the agent roturned to his Emperor.

In 2880 ( date doesn't agres ) when the old Dunkard Graveyerd was sold and the tombstones wers removed, the tombstones wore placed in coffins, which was buriod in Gresmount Cometery. The stones were orizy inches below the surfacs of the ground in lot "Ensor's plot. This information Mr. Wme Sitior, Robinsong Il.inois, claims was gotton from the kesper of the cemotery in 1899, Rumor has it that since that time, ons stones has been stolen.

A second agent from Germany later hastatedthis country and called upon the Secretary of the Stats, but was told to have Thaddeus Stephons, who was Congressman from that part of Penn. near York to investigate the merits of the claim. Stephens made an investigation and offered to secure the monay for $\$ 2500$ in cash and $15 \%$ of the gmount sgcured as a lage. fes. This proposition the Pennsylvania heirs tierbut those of old Baltimore failed to raise thoir part of the mbney for the cash in advance. So this plan also iailod. About this time soveral Societiss were formod for bringing the heirs together and winning the German Gold. $\mathrm{Mr}_{2}$ 。Wmositler, who has worked hardar than any one of the others of the helres for success has traveled all over the country writing down cinims and making svary offort to bring the haiss together.

In 1903 The Society made more dstermined efforts in the ratter of subseribed funds to send an agant from this countyy to carry on an imvestrgation in that country. And for this tasky the Reverend $J_{0} V$ George of Ponna. was selected and deppartod June 24. 1903. He landod in Beriin, Garmany, safelyo But was almost immediately takan 111 and spent some time in a hospital there. Howover, $\mathrm{Mr}^{2}$. Wm. Sitlar in his story, says that after Mr. George recovered he made a trip to Southern Germany and visitod members of the Sitler family at that place. He than called on the Consul and beturned to the U.S.A.

Tha heirs claimed that his effort madi in the later part of the yoar was unesatisfactory. Since that time the didferent Socistios have attained attoxnoys both in Gormany and in this Country as well, who give legal advise and claim that according to the reports from Germany and this country, overything points to a spaody recovery of the $\$ 350,000,000$ due tham from the Gemman Govermment, if only the heirs could agreo. It is said there are about 250 heirs in this country among whom the milifons must be devided. Of thesa thers ars about fifteon in this cityo

I received the following date from Mre Raymond Wessendorfs Spese, Indiana in November, 1957 She has the original penciled copy writton in 1905. It belonged to her grandfather, J8hn $\AA_{0}$ LeMastor, who was a decendent of Matthias Sitler, through Catherine Sitler, who married Jesse LaMaster. Mrs Wossendorf wrote me quotes "Now it was in 1905, late in the Pall of the yoar that my Mother and my grandfather both told ree many timos, that a Benjamin Sitler from Baltimore, Maryland came to Speed, Indiana looking for hoirs to the Sitier fortune. Now this fortuns was strictiy "Baltimore "Bocause a Matthias Sitler had disd in Baltimore and his estate was never settled. Much the sa me as the old German fartune in Bavaria, Germany. It too never reached it's rightful heirs. That was loit by the old Baron Matthias Von Sitler or Matthias, Sro My Grandfatiser always said that the Boltimore Matthias was the son of Herman who settled in York, $\mathrm{Pe} /$ then in Beltimore. Because the story of the struggle if you notice never does even mention Hermans name after they landed ( it says Districh in Berks County, Pennsylvania) (Matthias in in Yoxis. Pennsylvania. Question arises who बix this Baltimore Matthies then helong too.? It is said that onlytwo sons and one daughter left the old country ( Elizabeth) my Grandfather always said thet Catherine and Elizabeth that marrisd LaMasters were of a Hortesm generation. This could be, they could have been nemed for theico German kinfolk. But this Baltinore Matthias was wealthy in his own rights, not ever heving got the German Bonds or gold end quote。
