# Stroke Is Fatal To Dr. J. W. Clarke

## Physician Succumbs Satur- day; Funeral This Afternoon

Dr. J. W. Clarke, 74 years old, died at his home, 1429 Leitchfield road, at 8 o'clock Saturday morning of paralysis. Dr. Clarke was stricken last Sunday.

Born in the Glenville section of Daviess county, Dr. Clarke had been a resident of Daviess county the greater part of his life. He was graduated from the University of Louisville in 1889 and had practiced for forty-three years. He moved to Owensboro from Sacramento in 1924 and had since engaged in the practice of his profession here.

Surviving Dr. Clarke are his widow, Mrs. Julia Ellis Clarke, four daughters, Mrs. Thomas C. Roemer, of Bowling Green; Mrs. John C. Columbus, of Paintsville; Misses Elizabeth and Dorothy Sue Clarke, of Owensboro; three sons, J. W. Clarke, Jr., Thurman Clarke and Raymond E. Clarke, of Owensboro, and a brother, Thomas Clarke.

Funeral services will be conducted from the residence at 2:30 o'clock this afternoon with the Rev. Dawson C. Bryan, pastor of Settle Memorial Methodist church, officiating.
