Bute County, North Carolina Minutes of the Court of Pleas and Quarter Sessions, 1767-1779, Thursday after the second Tuesday in November 1768: Ordered that Moses Springfield orphan of Thomas Springfield be bound to Joshua Yarbrough until he attain to Lawful Age the said apprentice being now about the age of four years old, his said Master to Learn him to read & write and the trade of a Cooper.

There is another well establised line of Springfields in South Carolina. It starts with Thomas Springfield and Laodica. Another researcher list the parents of Thomas as being Thomas born about 1741 in Old Grandville, North Carolina and married to Martha. They do not list Moses as a son. The date of death of the elder Thomas was 20 Sep 1869 and the date of appoint of the Guardian for Moses was November 1868. I think it is likely that Moses was the son of Thomas and Martha.

Declaration of Moses Springfield, a soldier in the Revolution to obtain benefits of the Act of Congress passed the 7th of June 1832

State of North Carolina}Court of Pleas - Quarter Session Persons County }September Term 1832

This the 18th of September 1832 personally appeared in open Court before the Justices of Person County Court now sitting, Moses Springfield, a resident of the County and state aforesaid, aged sixty nine years, who being first sworn according to law doth on his oath make the following declaration. That he was born in the county of Franklin and state aforesaid that he afterwards removed to the county of Person. That he has no record of his age, but from memory he believes himself to be sixty nine years of age. That as a soldier, he entered the service of the United States under Captain Harding. That he was drafted from the militia of the county in which he lived that under Captain Harding he was marched to Ramsey's Mills in the county of Chatham and that he was stationed at said Mills fro the space of three months. That General Butler was the first to command, but that this declarant doth not now remember the names of any of his company officers save that his Captain. That from Ramsev's Mills he was marched to Hillsborough in the county of Orange in which town and the neighborhood of it he remained with his company for five months. That he and those composing his company were often sent out into the surrounding called counties to obtain supplies and some whom he assisted in taking and executing in said town of Hillsborough. That he was afterwards drafted for what was commonly

called in the militia "the eighteen months service" and under Captain Dickerson marched down into the southeastern part of this state and at some point on the Cape Fear he was discharged but that he received no written discharge. This declarant was engaged in no battle. That he has no documentary evidence that can be useful to him in the investigation of his claim by the Department. Dependant as he is entirely upon his memory both as to the time he entered and the time he was discharged from service he does pretend to give dates or years, but that from his best recollections he was engaged in actual service from nine to eleven months. And the declarant having ______ every claim to a pension except the present and declares that his name does not appear on the pension rolls of the agency of any state. This sworn to in open court.

We, William McKispack and John Smith, residing in the county of Person hereby certify that we are well acquainted with Moses Springfield who has subscribed and sworn to the above declaration, that he has sustained a good character for _____ and that he is reputed and believed in his neighborhood to have been a soldier of the Revolution.

State of North Carolina Person County: Court of Pleas & Quarter Sessions December Term 1834

On the 16th day of December 1834, appeared in open Court before the presiding Justices of said Court, aforesaid (it being a Court of record) Moses Springfield a resident citizen of Person County aged seventy years, who being duly sworn according to law doth upon his oath make the following amended declaration in order to obtain the benefit of the act of Congress passed June 7th 1832.

That upon a recurrence to his former declaration, he has discovered that his first term of Service has been totally omitted to be stated, but that in fact he was first drafted into the Service in the Militia of his County (then Caswell) under the command of Captain Frederick Debois or Debau for the term of 3 months, and was marched from Caswell Court house to Hillsboro where he was stationed as a guard and there continued until the expiration of his term. That in the year 1781 he was again drafted and put under Captain Hardin or Harding and was again marched from Caswell Courthouse to Ramsey's Mills as stated in his former declaration and served as heretofore stated the term of 3 months under General Butler, he now remembers no it had escaped his memory when his first declaration was made that the Lieutenant of his company was Thomas Barnett.

He now states that for some error in himself or his Scribe, the Circumstances related as having occurred at Hillsboro during this tour occurred in his first tour in 1780 under Captain Debois and were unaccountably confounded in his first declaration with the events of this second tour of 3 months under Captain Hardin. He remained at Ramsey's Mills in full 3 months for which he was drafted and was there discharged. That he subsequently entered the service by draft for 18 months under Captain Dickson the date of his Service he cannot now remember though it was shortly after the termination of his second tour at Ramsey's Mills and was marched into the South eastern part of the State, but long before the termination of his term of Service he was discharged near the Cape Fear River he cannot say how long he served in the last engagement - but he is very certain that in all the various tours he served at least 9 months, that he now knows no one surviving who served with him except John Clayton1 who served his two first tours in the same company, and Coleman Clayton2 who served under Captain Hardin at Ramsays Mills - This declarant is frail of memory having for 13 years been afflicted with a Stroke of the palsy he is therefore unable to state the particulars with entire certainty - that he has been careful to state nothing which is not well impressed on his memory.

This amended Application has been delayed on account of the laws of the papers for more than a year.

TEXT OF THE LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT OF THOMAS SPRINGFIELD Recorded in Will Book C, pages 16 9-171 Apt. 10, File No. 28SC-AR-M 9/16 AD 539 SC WILL TRANSCRIPTS 1782-1868 /Roll 16, VOL . I/1766-1825.

In the name of God Amen I Thomas Springfield of Greenville District and State of South Carolina being weak of Body but of sound mind and memory thanks be to God for the Same do make this my last will and testament in manner and form following that is to say first I recommend my soul to God who gave it and my body to the dust to be decently buried by the directions of my executors who I shall hereafter name appoint.

Item I, I give to my son Aaron Springfield one hundred dollars to be paid out of my estate by my executors and

to my son James Springfield I give ten dollars to be paid by my executors out of my estate to my son Hugh Springfield I give Fifty dollars to be paid by my executors out of my estate. To my Daughter Patsy Magness I give her one hundred dollars to be paid to my executors out of my estate.

To my son Thomas Springfield I give a Negro boy named Adam and a large family Bible. I give to my son Bennett Springfield all the woodland that lies on the South side of the road that runs from my house to Moons.

I give to my daughter Sarah Bates a Negro girl named Jin.

To my Daughter Nancy Miller, I give two thirds of the profit of a Negro woman named Liza and at the decease of the said Nancy Miller, this part of the Said Negro to be equally divided between Nancy Miller's four children, viz., Mahalia, Dicae said Negro woman named Liza viz Franklin, Henry, Thomas and Jasper.

To my granddaughter Sarah Springfield, I give one hundred acres of land the plantation hereon I now live and house and I also give her one Negro boy named Good also one feather stead and furniture.

To my grandson Pinkney Springfield I give a certain parcel or track of land Bounded by my home track and bounded by Lemmons land and by Moons land containing 70 acres more or less.

My Negro George is to be sold and all my loose property and stock and all kinds to be sold and my debts paid out of the proceeds. And if there is more money than pays my debts I want it equally divided between my three grandchildren viz Dyca, Harkins and Nansey Harkins and Thomas Springfield in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this the twenty eight day of October Eighteen hundred and forty three.

He graduated from Cincinnati Medical College in June, 1874, and located for the practice of medicine in West Louisville, the same year. In 1875 he removed to his farm in this precinct, where he still lives, and has built up a large practice. He also carries on farming and stock-raising. He married in 1875, to Mrs. Rafferty, daughter of the late Lewis I. Burns, of this county. They had two children, on living - Aurelia. Mrs. Springfield died June 20, 1880, and March 10, 1881, the Doctor married Miss Belle Aull, daughter of Robert P. Aull, deceased. They had one child - Ansel. MOSES STREET JONES

The name Jones is of Welsh origin. Researchers found that it was first spelled Johnys, then Johnes and later Jones. My great grandfather Moses Jones was born May 27, 1797 in Mecklenburg County, Virginia. He was the son of Richard and Jane Comer Jones. It has been said that his parents were accident victims which left their son an orphan at an early age. A maternal family friend named Thomas Street of Person Coun-ty, NC took the lad and raised him.

Appreciation of the kindness of the man who befriended him caused Moses Jones to name one of his sons Moses Street Jones. My grandfather Moses Street Jones was born March 2, 1834 in Person County. He was seventh of ten children of Moses and Joanna Boltin Springfield Jones who were married November 11, 1819.

Other children are: Richard, born 9-15--1820, married Martha Ann Gentry 1-10-1839, death date unknown; William, born 9-6-1822, married Jane Brooks 12-15-1842, died 2-29--1896, buried beside his wife in Shiloh Church Cemetery; Elizabeth Comer Jones, born 9-26-1824, married William Walker 11-25-1840, died 6-1-1851; James Wesley, born 11-5--1826, married Mahaly S. Burton 4-20-1848, death date unknown; John Richmond born 6-20-1829, died 2-26-1897 (Tombstone has birthdate 8-1-1829); Gabriel Yancey born 2--17-1832 died 4-26-1862, buried in Jones Family Cemetery; Calvin born 8-11-1836, married Patty Morton, buried at Milton; Jane Jones born 9-6-1839, married John B. Day 11-28-1860; Threeza Loyd born 10-5-1842, married a Southerland and moved to Missouri.

Moses S. Jones was a slim man of medium height with blue grey eyes and reddish hair. He wore a beard most of his adult life. He loved to work and worked long hours on the farm. He was known to complain that he was never able to lift a "2 bushel sack of shelled corn." During his life time Moses S. Jones was astute in buying and selling land. At one time he owned several thousand acres of land in the Bethel Hill, Woodsdale areas and in Virginia along the border plus property in the town of Roxboro. He established a home in Woods-dale township about five miles from the Virginia line. Tenant families worked the land either for half or fourth share of their profit depending on whether they owned their team (mules). In 1909 Mr. Jones built a brick vaneer hotel in Roxboro on the site of the frame Dowdy Hotel (site of present P.H. Rose Store). It was known as the Jones Hotel until it was renamed Hotel Roxboro. It was abolished in 1961.

Moses S. Jones was one of the 12 men granted certificate of incorporation for the Peoples Bank (now First Union) chartered dur-ing the 1891 session of the N.C. legislature.

During the Civil War, Moses S. Jones was a soldier in Company K of the 12th N.C. Regiment, under General Early. While in service he had measles and stayed in a feed barn until he was able to return to duty.

Moses S. Jones was past forty years old when in 1880 he married the first time. His wife was Bettie King Rogers, a widow eight years his junior, with one son Zeb Rogers. She died a few years later and was buried in the Rogers cemetery at Woodsdale. Mr. Jones provided for his step-son to attend A & E College (N.C. State) to study Architectural En-gineering. According to my mother, Zeb Rogers designed Pennsylvania Railroad Station in Washington, D.C.

On March 1, 1894 Moses S. Jones married a seconflime, Addie F. Jones of Brunswick County, Virginia. Unfortunately, she died October 22, 1895, one day after giving birth to a daughter. The inlant was named Addie Garnett. Two years later Mr. Jones married Ida Jones, his second wife's sister. Ten years later in 1907 Moses Jones was a widower for the third time.

Grandfather's mother Joanna lived with him for many years after her husband's death in August 1854. She was 98 years, 2 months of age when she died in 1897. Both Moses and his wife Joanna are buried in the Jones Family Cemetery. Also, Joanna's parents Moses and Betsy Springfield are buried in the Jones Family Cemetery. This cemetery is located near the Moses Jones' family home which now stands empty and in bad repair. The home site is located about one mile bff State Road 1322 approximately three forth mile East of Woodsdale.

Though he had little formal education, M.S. Jones was an advocate of education. Besides providing for his step son's education, he gave financial assistance to ministerial students who attended Bethel Hill Institute, the board-ing school founded by the Rev. J.A. Beam. Later, when the need arose for a more centrally located school in the community, Mr. Jones was serving on the local school board. He gave land and the rough timber for a new elementary school at the site of the present Bethel Hill school. Date of deed is September 1919. Anticipating that he would have grand-children to be educated (I was the only one in 1919) grandfather set up a scholarship fund at Meredith and Wake Forest Colleges. Four grandchildren benefitted from these scholarships.

Moses S. Jones was 86 when he died May 19, 1920. He is buried beside his second wife Addie at Bethel Hill Church where he had been a faithful and contributing member.
