Roger Shackelford who emigrated from England to the Virginia Colony about the middle of the 17th century is the first Shackelford to be mentioned in the public records in America. It is known that one Edward Palmer received a patent or grant of land of 400 acres in Gloucester County, Virginia for the transportation of eight persons into Virginia, including Roger Shackelford. The date of this grant was 4 June 1658. Edward Palmor had a sister, Mary, on the above list and there is good reason to believe, though no proof, that Rogor Shackelford married Mary Palmer.

The first time that Roger Shackelford appears as of record is the year 1678 when he is granted 313 acres of land in Gloucester County. This was not the first land he had possessed in Virginia evidenced by the wording

of the document found in Land Book VI at page 665.

Among the numerous family records in England, included is the Will of John Shackolford, a butcher of New Alresford. It was dated March 26 1647 and proved in Bishop's Court, Winchestor, March 30 1647. In this Will ho montioned his cousins: Richard Shackelford, John Shackelford, Ann Shackelford, and five children of his cousin John Shackolford, doceased. The five children of the deceased John were as follows:

(1) John Shackelford, baptized Old Alresford, December 23, 1647.

(2) Roger Shackelford, baptized Old Alresford, April 23, 1629.

(3) Charles Shackelford, baptized Old Alresford, January 25, 1630.

(4) Christophor Shackelford, baptized Old Alresford, March 10, 1632. (5) Ingram Shackolford, baptized Old Alresford, October 12, 1636.

The date of Roger's death is unknown but his name appears on the Quit Rent Rell for 1704. He is known to have had four sons, namely - James, Francis, John and Zachariah. Also, Bonjamin, Charles, Rogor, Jr. and William have been added to the list.

John Shackolford, progenitor of the branch of the family in western Kontucky, rosided in Culpoper County, Virginia in the early 1760's. This information from the Ponsion potition of his son, Mordocai, who sorved in the Revolutionary War as a substitute for his father. He states he was born in said county. John, the father, was a member of Peter Hogg's Rangors in the war against the Indians in 1755 and is mentioned as shoriff at one time in Pittsylvania County. He married Mary Anne White, daughter of Joromiah. Jeromiah White left a Will in Albemarle County, Va., dated in 1777, in which he named, among several others, a daughter: Anne Shackelford. It will be noted that they named a son, Jeromiah.

Wo also know that John and Anno owned land in Elbort County, Goorgia but there is no proof of their ever living there. They show up in Washington County, Ky., in 1796 and later sold the Georgia land to Ezokiel Bailey. Later, about 1802, they moved to Shelby County where they purchased several hundred acros of land and made this their home during their later years, togethor. John's doath occurred in the latter part of 1819 and was survived

by his wife, Anne.

To my son--Jeromiah Shackelford, I leave my plantation containing 175acres of land.

I have given to my sons -- John, William and Sterling Shackelford, and

to my daughter -- Nancy R. Gregory, 50-acres of land, each.

I give to my son, William, my negro boy, Nat. And to my son, Mordocai, I will \$550.00 (five hundred and fifty dollars) which is to be raised by

To my son--Storling Shackelford, I give my negro boy, Barber.

To the heirs of my deceased son--John Shackolford, I will \$400.00 (four hundred dollars) to be equally divided between them and the children of my deceased daughter, Nancy R. Gregory.

After the death of my wife-- Anne Shackelford, all my personal property, and my two negroes, Cupid and Dilce, to be sold, and if the sales of the property hereby directed to be sold should bring more money than is devised by this will, the everplus to be divided into two equal parts, one for Betsy Ballard and one for Milly Shackelford.

I appoint my wife -- Anne Shackelford, and my son, William Shackelford,

and William Howlett to be my executors.

That he joined the main Army under General Green on the twelfth day of March 1781 at the High Rock Ford on the Haw River and was with Gen. Green at the Battle of Guilford Courthouse on the fifteenth of March 1781 under Gen. Stevens. That he again entered the service under Capt. Charles Hutchins about the first of August 1781 as a substitute in the place of his father JOHN SHACKELFORD and served out his time and got his discharge at Boyd's ferry on Dan River, that in the last tour he was commanded by Colonel Williams and they were embodied at the Halifax old town in Pittsylvania County, Virginia and went to Walden's Springs and then back to Halifax old town. That in the last tour he was not attached to any regular or Continental troops. That in his first tour he was acquainted with General Green and Colonel Washington. That he was well acquainted with Colonel Cooke who commanded the Regiment he was in on the day of the battle of Guilford and from that time until he was discharged which was at Ramseur Mill on Deep River in the State of North Carolina and that both his discharges are lost he not expecting they would ever be needed."

RAMSEUR is a town on the Deep River in Randolph Co., NC located s. of Franklinville & just w. of Chatham Co. (Probably there was a gristmill there as there were in most river towns.)

Henry Guthrie was born in Hanover County, Virginia. He applied for a pension Sept. 10 1832, in the circuit court for the District of West Tenn. He said he fought as a private in the North Caroline Line. He served several terms as a gunsmith and was wounded near the end of the War. He was a signer of the Cumberland Compact on May 1,1780.

Henry Guthrie and his partner drilled a well for salt water near Nashville Salt Springs in 1791, but they got sulphur water. He was living in Davidson County, Tenn. Jan. 4, 1837. Guthrie's wife Nancy Ann Skackelford Guthrie, applied for a pension in 1851. She died in 1870.

Henry Guthrie is buried in the old Guthrie graveyard near the Nolensville Community of Williamson County, Tenn.

This home, called Traveller's Rest, has been restored and is open to the public. (It's at 636 Ferrell Parkway, in Nashville. It's right off Franklin Road, and there are some signs that direct you to it. It's not far from Overton High School.) The contract specified the carpenter would be paid by title to a 320 acre tract on Stone's River owned by Overton, at the rate of two dollars per acre. Frederick Binkley received title to this land on 1 Jun 1801. David Cumming was bondsman on the marriage of Frederick to Adeline. On the bond, Frederick signed his name Pinkley. The family graveyard of Frederick Binkley was originally on a hill near his home. During construction of J. Percy Priest Dam, the graves were moved to Mt. Juliet Cemetery.

Germanton was the county seat. On 16 Jan 1849, the NC General Assembly placed a portion of Stokes into Forsyth Co. In 1844, Samuel Shackelford purchased a tract of land on the Dan River. The river hills iron mines were thriving on Moody's forge from workers and boatmen. Thus, a tavern was built on a trail west of the river and forge by Shackelford. In March 1849, the court ordered commissioners to erect a courthouse and jail to be completed by mid-1851. The commissioners needed a meeting place to pick a site for the new county seat. Since

taverns were a popular meeting place, Shackelford's tavern became as good a place to meet as any. On 10 Jun 1849, Shackelford sold to William A. Lash, 47 acres of land for \$75.00 on the Dan River and Buck Island Road. Prior to making the deal public, several of the J.P.'s hurriedly bought the land in the immediate neighborhood for the 'sole purpose of speculation. This 'unethical behavior' and a chief reason for naming this spot the county seat was that strong drink was available."
