

## *Descendants of Mark Hardin*

### *Generation No. 1*

1. MARK<sup>2</sup> HARDIN (*MARTIN*<sup>1</sup>)<sup>1</sup> was born October 20, 1681 in Staten Island, New York, and died May 01, 1735 in Prince William County, Virginia. He married MARY HOGUE Unknown. She was born 1688, and died 1755 in Northumberland, Virginia.

Notes for MARK HARDIN:

Mark Hardin first appears in the Virginia records in Northumberland County, 7 April, 1707, when he was deeded 50 acres of land by the heirs of John Melton, decd. On 22 September, 1715, he had a runaway servent returned to him by William Branes of Maryland.

While still living in Northumberland County, he had in 1716 two grants of 94 acres and 122 1/2 acres in Richmond County. On 14 March, 1720, Mark Hardin and his wife Mary of Richmond County deeded away the land that he had bought in Northumberland County in 1707.

A grant of 642 acres in Stafford County 4, March, 1722/23, calls him Mark Hardin of George County. Another 232 acres in Stafford County was granted him 24 July, 1724. All or most of this land was in what later became the Elk Run District of Prince William County, not far from Germantown.

Mark Hardin's will dated 16 March, 1734/35 and probated in Prince William County, Virginia, 21 May, 1735, leaves land to his eldest son John, and his other sons, Martin, Mark and Henry, with the stipulation that if any of the last named sons die without issue, their land is to fall to the daughters, Ann and Alice Hardin; to the daughter Elizabeth Hardin he also leave 100 acres of land bought of James McDonald; to sons and daughter John, Martin, Mark, Henry and Martha McDonald 2 shillings each; wife to be satisfied with her dower in the 200 acres left to the son Mark; after the wifes decease, the rest of the estate to be divided among the 5 daughters, Abigail, Mary, Ann, Elizabeth and Alice; wife Mary and sons John and Martin, executors. The will indicates that none of the children were married except Martha MdDonald and perhaps John.

### *Generation No. 2*

2. MAJOR JOHN<sup>3</sup> HARDIN (*MARK*<sup>2</sup>, *MARTIN*<sup>1</sup>) was born 1710 in Northumberland, Virginia, and died October

13, 1789 in Nelson County, Kentucky. He married CATHERINE MARR Unknown. She was born Unknown, and died Aft. 1780.

Notes for MAJOR JOHN HARDIN:

John Hardin moved about 1740 to Frederick County, Virginia; built the first stone courthouse in Winchester; served as Captain of Militia in the French and Indian War; Sheriff of Frederick County' bought land in Hampshire County, VA 1762, and moved there. Captain and Major in the border campaigns of the American Revolution' reported the death of Major Crawford at Fort Pitt in 1782 to the Virginia authorities; one of the first justices of Monongalia County; moved to Nelson County, Kentucky, 1786, and lived alone in a cabin east of Hardin's Station which had been established in 1780 by his son, Captain William Hardin; He was killed by Indians on the Brandenburg Road about a mile from Hardinsburg, Kentucky.

In 1785 and 1786 two grants for 400 acres each were made to him in Jefferson County, Kentucky on Hardin's Creek, near the land of his son William.

Notes for MARK HARDIN:

The records show that Mark Hardin was in Prince William County, VA, until 1755 when he sold his property to his brother, Martin. He then moved to Frederick County where he was paid for services in the French and Indian War in September, 1758. He also seems to have lived in Culpeper County around this time and was paid there too for his War services. After 1758 he disappears from the records and he may have moved to Pittsylvania County, VA, with his brother Henry, and is the same Mark Hardin who was an overseer there in 1767. He also appears in the tax lists there for 1782 and 1783.

The children of Mark and Elizabeth Hardin are uncertain but one of them appears to have been a son, Mark, who married a Crittenden and moved to Kentucky.

Notes for CAPTAIN JOHN HARDIN, JR.:

The lands in early Western Pennsylvania were in dispute between Virginia and Pennsylvania, and Virginia sent troops under General Clark to appropriate land in 1781. In Edgar W. Hassler's "Old Westmoreland" he states, "One of the most vigorous in denouncing the Virginia proceedings was Captain John Hardin, who kept a gristmill at Redstone. At the head of 40 or 50 horsemen, General Clark visited Hardin's settlement, announcing his purpose to hang the stubborn old pioneer, Hardin could not be found, but the Virginians caught one of his sons and kept him imprisoned several days. (The troops destroyed property) and feasted for three days at Hardin's expense. Then General Clark declared the old man's estate forfeited for treason, but was kind enough to give the property to the wife."

John Hardin participated in many Indian battles and was a captain under Colonel Angus McDonald's force of 400 men who marched to the forks of Muskingum in order to engage the Indians in battle but found the village deserted. This was 22 August, 1774. The army was ambushed on the way and Captain Hardin was wounded in the knee.

Captain Hardin was also a company commander in Colonel William Crawford's disastrous campaign at Upper Sandusky. This battle occurred on 4 June, 1782.

The Americans were surrounded by troops and outnumbered more than two to one and it was obvious that a retreat was necessary. Colonel Crawford ordered a general retreat through the enemy lines and Captain Hardin disobeyed his orders and took his company and struck out alone and made it back to Fort Pitt with no casualties. Colonel Crawford was captured and burned at the stake.

It is said that John Hardin had an illegitimate son named Jack Hardin.

The will of John Hardin (now called John Hardin, Sr.) of Spring Hill Township, Fayette County, PA, was dated 13 May, 1803 and probated in Bedford County, PA. It mentions his children.

Notes for WILLIAM HARDIN:

William (Indian Bill) Hardin was a noted Indian fighter, mentioned prominently in Perrin's "History of Breckenridge County before 1840," was Captain in the Militia, was nicknamed "Indian Bill" for his prowess against the Indians, and in his obituary is called "Colonel William Hardin."

An article called "Interesting History of Indian Bill Hardin, " by Henry C. Jolly in the "Breckenridge Document, April 25, 1902, " states that in August 1779, he and his his cousin Sinclair Hardin, and two other companions came to Kentucky and visited the vicinity of Hardinsburg, where William Hardin killed one Indian and his cousin was killed by another. They then visited the country of the present Hardin County, Kentucky, and William was so pleased with the country that he went back to Pennsylvania, gathered a group of 12 families there, and in 1780 they set out for Kentucky, arriving at the present site of Louisville March 6, 1781. They then journeyed back to Hardin's Creek and on March 17, 1781, began clearing the land for Hardin's fort which later became Hardinsburg, Kentucky.

It was said that "Indian Bill" was a perfect specimen of a man. He stood 6 feet 6 inches and weighed 240 pounds. He was just about the same size as Simon Kenton (probably the most noted of all the Indian fighters) and it was reported that both men could run all day. No doubt Simon and "Indian Bill" fought against the Indians many times together. William Hardin and his brothers were raised on the western frontier of Pennsylvania and it was here that they became adept at Indian fighting. You had to if you were to survive.

William Hardin received grants from the state of Virginia in 1785 for 3800 acres of land, all near the present site of Hardinsburg, Kentucky.

Col. John Hardin was an American Army officer in the Revolutionary War and in later Indian Wars. He grew to manhood in the wilderness of southwestern Pennsylvania, becoming a skilled woodsman and



marksman. At the start of the American Revolution, he became a second lieutenant in the Continental Army and joined Daniel Morgan's famous corps of rifleman. He served with distinction in many missions and engagements, notably at the Battle of Saratoga, but resigned from the Army in 1779.

In 1786, he settled in Nelson, (later Washington County, Kentucky) and took part in the campaigns against the Indians in the Northwest Territory under George Rogers Clark and other leaders. He was murdered in 1792 while trying to negotiate a truce with the Indians in what is now the city of Hardin, Ohio. Counties in Kentucky and Ohio were named in his honor.

He was a personal friend of George Washington and attended many parties at Mt. Vernon.

William (Indian Bill) Hardin was a noted Indian fighter, mentioned prominently in Perrin's "History of Breckenridge County before 1840," was a Captain in the Militia, was nicknamed "Indian Bill" for his prowess against the Indians, and in his obituary is called "Colonel William Hardin."

An article called "Interesting History of Indian Bill Hardin, " by Henry C. Jolly in the "Breckenridge Document, April 25, 1902, " states that in August 1779, he and his his cousin Sinclair Hardin, and two other companions came to Kentucky and visited the vicinity of Hardinsburg, where William Hardin killed one Indian and his cousin was killed by another. They then visited the country of the present Hardin County, Kentucky, and William was so pleased with the country that he went back to Pennsylvania, gathered a group of 12 families there, and in 1780 they set out for Kentucky, arriving at the present site of Louisville March 6, 1781. They then journeyed back to Hardin's Creek and on March 17, 1781, began clearing the land for Hardin's fort which later became Hardinsburg, Kentucky.

It was said that "Indian Bill" was a perfect specimen of a man. He stood 6 feet 6 inches and weighed 240 pounds. He was just about the same size as Simon Kenton (probably the most noted of all the Indian fighters) and it was reported that both men could run all day. No doubt Simon and "Indian Bill" fought against the Indians many times together. William Hardin and his brothers were raised on the western frontier of Pennsylvania and it was here that they became adept at Indian fighting. You had to if you were to survive.

William Hardin received grants from the state of Virginia in 1785 for 3800 acres of land, all near the present site of Hardinsburg, Kentucky.
