Will of John Robertson - Nelson County, Ky. Will Book C - page 163

In the name of God Amen. I, John Robertson of Nelson County State of Kentucky being of sound mind do make and ordain this my last will and testament in manner following. Viz. My eldest daughter by a former wife named Sally having married Martin H. Wickliffe and received soon afterwards a compensation in full for a child's part and she has since departed this life, her representative is to receive no more from my estate. I leave my estate in the hands of my present wife, Polly, in Trust during her life and after her death to be equally divided among her nine children. Viz. Betsy, William, Gilly, Richard, Nancy, Matilda, John Handley & Cyrus and whatever my said wife may choose to let any of them have by way of advancement must be considered as in trust and a part of my estate, my Daughter Gilly excepted who received a negro woman and child and her husband, Cornelius Bodine advanced two hundred Dollars for the use to my daughter Betsy's Husband, Saml. Handley which must be considered as so much advanced to said Saml. Handley. My desire is that my son William act as Executor to this my last will and testament with full power and authority to sell or dispose of any part of my estate (with the approbation of his mother) for the payment of debts, etc. as he shall Judge expedient, any law to the contrary not withstanding. In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal the Twenty fourth day of March 1812.

At a County Court held for Nelson County on Monday the 13th day of November, 1813

This last will and testament of John Robertson, deceased, was proved by the Oaths of William Watson, Samuel Watson & John Goodlett Subscribing Witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded and on motion of William N. Robertson, The Executor therein named having taken the oath prescribed by law and Executed bond with John Bodine, Cornelius Bodine & William Watson his Securities in the penalty of \$4,000 Conditioned according to law. It is ordered that Certificate of Probate of said will be granted the said Executor.

John Robertson (1753-1813) son of William Robertson by 1st wife (name unknown) served in the American Revolution as Lieut. in the Virginia Continental line. He married 1st ca 1783 in Virginia Elizabeth Williams; 2nd 27 Mar. 1787 Nelson County Mary Parker, daughter of Richard Parker and Grizelle Nalle from Culpeper County, Virginia. Several children of John Robertson came to Daviess and McLean Counties.

JONAS LITTLE FAMILY

Jonas Little was born 11 Feb. 1780 at Newberry, Union District, South Carolina, one of five sons and five daughters born to George and Mary (?) Little natives of Scotland. George Little served in the American Revolution and attained the rank of Captain. Years later after the decease of his first wife he married Mary (Handley) Douglas, widow of Alexander Douglas. About the year 1799 Jonas married Elizabeth "Betsy" Douglas, the daughter of his stepmother. In 1803 the Littles started their migration to Kentucky. Jonas and wife, Betsy with two or three small children accompanied by their parents, arrived in 1804 at Fort Vienna (Calhoun) and settled five miles north of that point. This was later known as Little's Crossroads, now Guffie. It was here the family resided through the years and Jonas was laid to rest in Old Brushy Fork Cemetery located on his farm. His death occurred on 12 April 1850, his wife survived him by several years.

1. Martha Little born ca 1800 in South Carolina; married first 9 March 1824 Benjamin Humphrey, son of Daniel and Catherine Humphrey.
