

LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT

OF

HENRY BOOKER ROBERTSON

I, HENRY BOOKER ROBERTSON, a resident of Lake Placid, Florida, do hereby make and declare this to be my Last Will and Testament, revoking all previous Wills and Codicils.

I.

I direct that all estate, inheritance, succession or other death taxes, including interest and penalties assessed thereon, which become due by reason of my death either upon property or interests passing under this Will or upon property or interest passing by means other than this Will, shall be paid out of my general estate as part of the expenses of administration.

II.

I intentionally incorporate the provisions of the Uniform Simultaneous Death Act as presently codified at KRS 397.020, et. seq.

III.

I devise and bequeath all of my property, both real, personal and mixed, and wheresoever situated, in equal shares, to my wife, Ruth Robertson, and five of my six children, Adley Booker Robertson, Daviess County, Kentucky; Hazel Doris Kapperman, Marietta, Georgia; Norma R. Jobe, Huntington, West Virginia; Charles Herman Robertson, Polk County, Florida; and Joyce R. Floyd, Daviess County, Kentucky, share and share alike, absolutely and in fee simple.

IV.

If any of the beneficiaries under this Will and I should die as the result of a common disaster, then this Will shall take effect as if such beneficiary had failed to survive me.

V.

To my spouse, Ruth Robertson, I give a terminable life estate in my residence at Lake Placid, Florida, if owned by me at the time of my death, specifically, that Ruth Robertson shall have the right to live in

and occupy the residence as her personal residence for her remaining lifetime for so long as she remains unmarried. Upon her remarriage, death, or abandonment of the residence as her personal residence, I give the remainder interest therein without reservation to be divided equally among her and five of my six children in equal one-sixth (1/6) shares. She shall have the vehicle we now own as her own separate property.

VI.

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At the time of this Will several of my children are indebted to me. These debts are evidenced by various promissory notes. It is my desire that these notes be called upon my death and all sums due thereon together with any unpaid interest be paid into my estate. These sums shall be included with any other funds on hand in my estate after liquidation and the total amount equally divided among my children with the exception of Carole Ferguson, who has previously received my farm and therefore has received sufficient assets from my estate, and wife, Ruth Robertson, in equal shares, share and share alike. It is not my intention to cancel any indebtedness that Carole Ferguson might owe to me at the time of my death.

Any of my children who are presently indebted to me shall be allowed to set off against the amount they owe my estate. For example, should one child owe \$10,000.00 to the estate and their share from the cash on hand would be \$5,000.00, they would need to pay in only \$5,000.00.

It is my desire by this to equalize the amounts that each of the children will receive from my estate. Certain of my children have borrowed and some have not and by this means I hope to equalize the shares that would be received upon my death.

VII.

I nominate and appoint as Executor of this Will, my son, Adley Booker Robertson. I direct that no bond or other surety be required of the party nominated hereby.

VIII.

I give my Executor full power and authority at discretion to pay all of my just debts, funeral expenses and expenses of my terminal

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illness, if any; to invest, reinvest, sell, purchase and mortgage  
the proceeds of my estate, including both real and personal property,  
as the exercise of sound judgment may dictate such action for the  
best interest of my estate, if any such property must be sold or  
dealt with to pay the debts or costs of administration of my estate  
and such assets cannot be distributed in kind or are not bequeathed  
in kind as set forth in the preceding Articles of this will, all of  
such powers to be exercisable by my Executor without necessity of  
Order of Court. However, if my estate shall be sufficient to make  
the bequests enumerated herein in kind, without sale of any of such  
assets, then I require distribution in kind where specified. In  
addition, should my estate be sufficient, I give to my Executor  
the power to make advancements as necessary for my surviving beneficiaries,  
in such amounts and at such terms as my Executor may determine desirable  
and feasible considering the nature of the my estate.

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IN WITNESS AND AFFIRMATION, I have signed this as my Last Will and  
Testament on this the 31 day of July, 1984, typewritten  
on four pages, each page initialed by me at the foot thereof.
