CALHOUN, Ky. —Bayne Pride, 85, of Calhoun, died Wednesday, Feb. 28, 2007, at his residence.

He was born Oct. 21, 1921, in Clay, Ky., to Frank and Jewell Vaughn Pride. He attended the University of Kentucky for two years and received his bachelor of science degree in commercial art from Woodbury College in Los Angeles. He was a commercial artist and co-owner of A & B Sign Co. in Madisonville from 1959 until 1973. He owned and operated Pride Graphics in McLean County, Ky. He was a member of First Baptist Church in Madisonville. He served in the U.S. Air Force during World War II. He was a Kentucky Colonel, and a member of Madisonville Veterans of Foreign Wars and American Legion.
