

Ellis H. Vanover, 89, formerly of Panther, died Sunday, July 8, 1979, at Hermitage Manor Nursing Home. He was born in Daviess County, and was a retired farmer and schoolteacher. He began teaching in 1909 and taught at Blandford, Short, Zion, Panther and Snyder schools. He also was the first operator of the Bookmobile in Daviess County.
