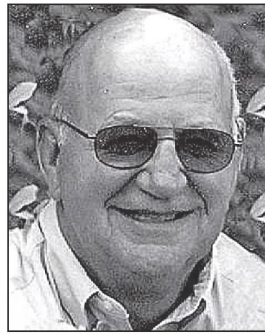


Glenn Williams
